Build a window wildlife hide





Step 1: Dismantle an old cardboard box, removing any tape. You may need to cut one side to leave you with a large open sheet.

Step 2: Hold the cardboard sheet against the window for a rough guide of the width needed. Cut to size, making sure it fits neatly inside the window frame.

Step 3: Cut away any access cardboard, but leave the bottom of the box in tact to form a ledge to help keep your hide sitting upright.



Step 4: Mark rectangles where you would like your viewing windows to be and cut out three sides - leaving the top as a flap.

Step 5: Add handles by sticking two pieces of masking tape together.
